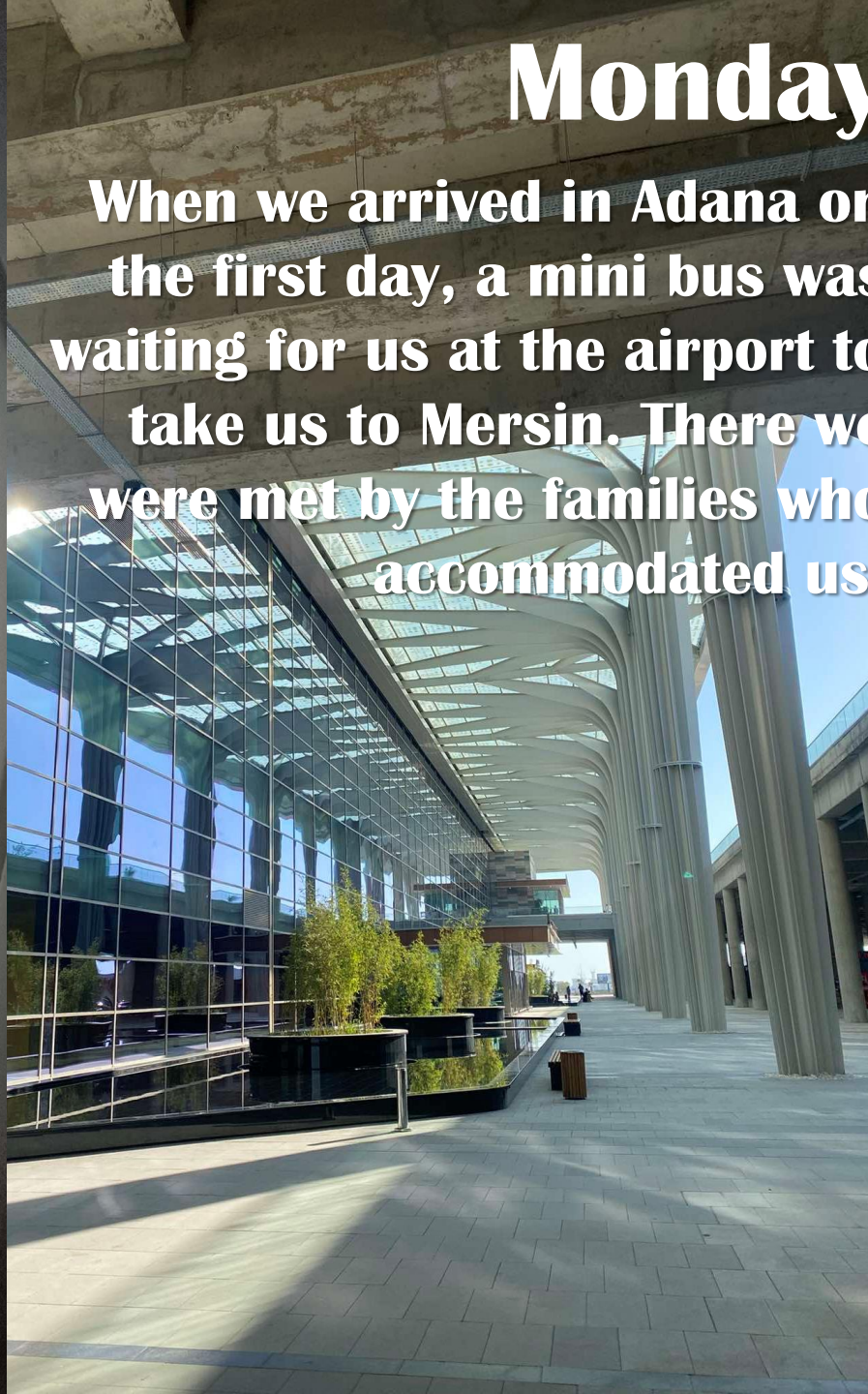

**In the afternoon we met friends of our hosts and they taught us Turkish while we visited an even bigger shopping centre than the one they took us to yesterday.**



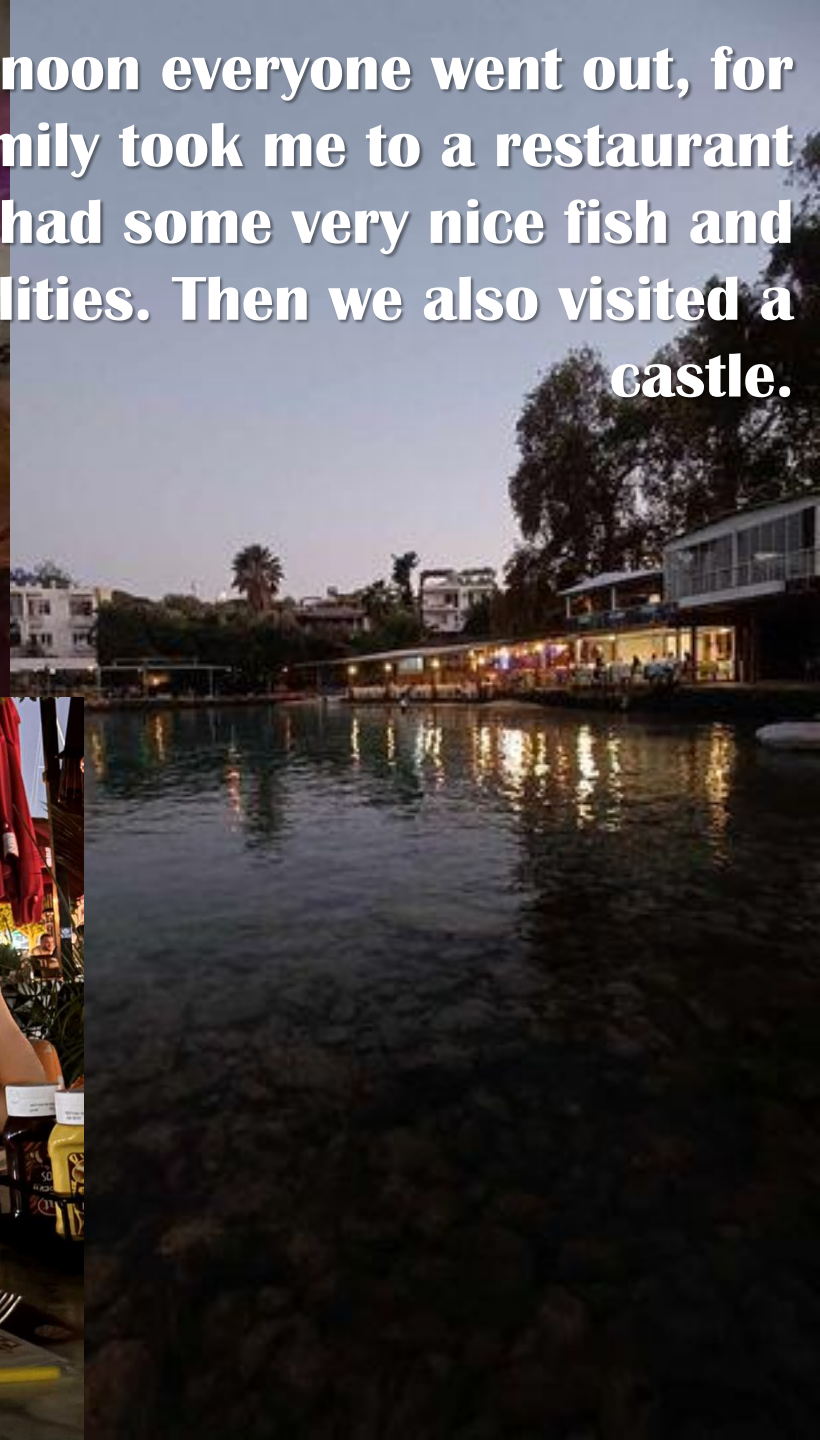


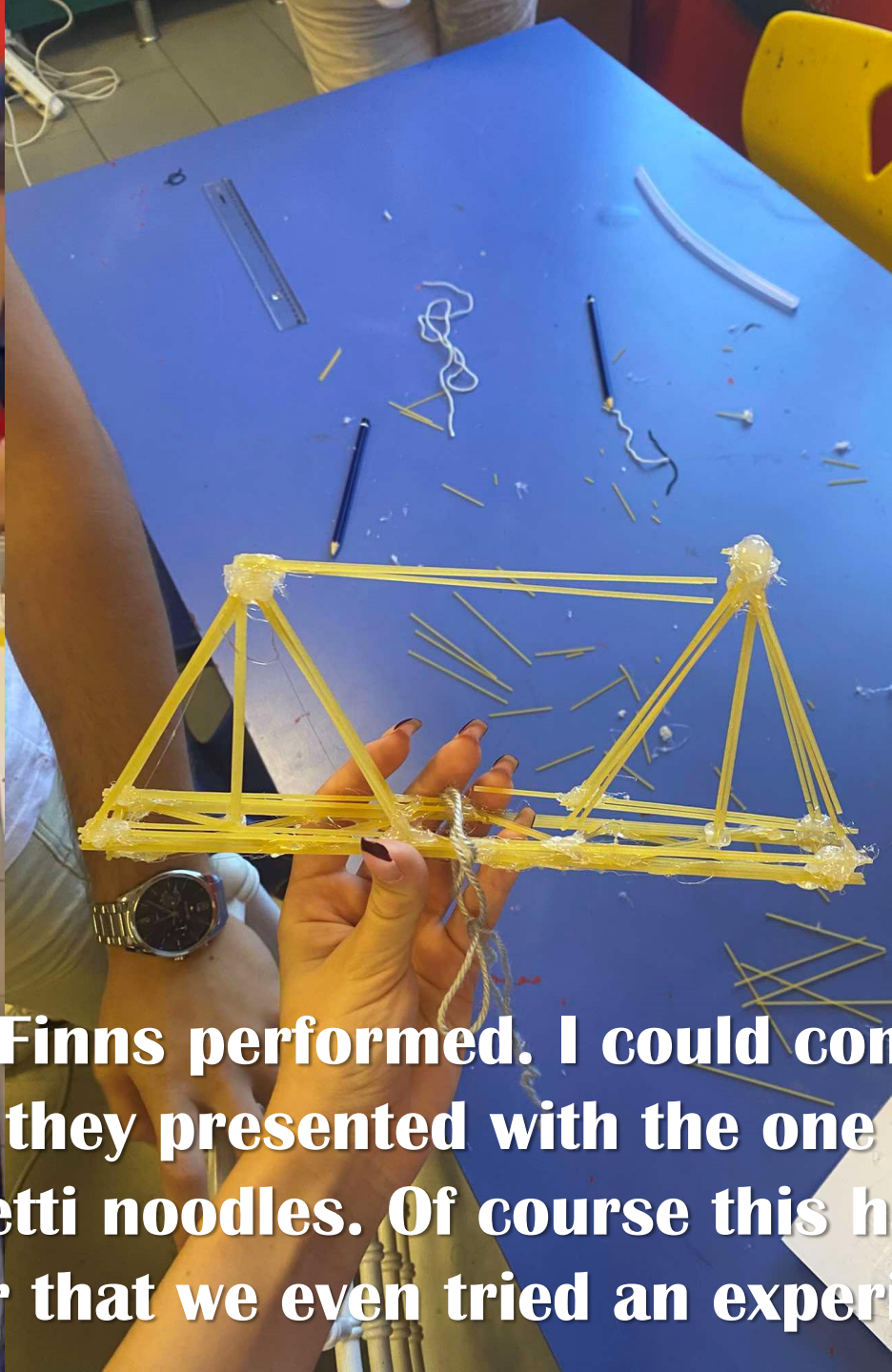
**tuesday**

In the afternoon everyone went out, for example my family took me to a restaurant where I had some very nice fish and Turkish specialities. Then we also visited a castle.

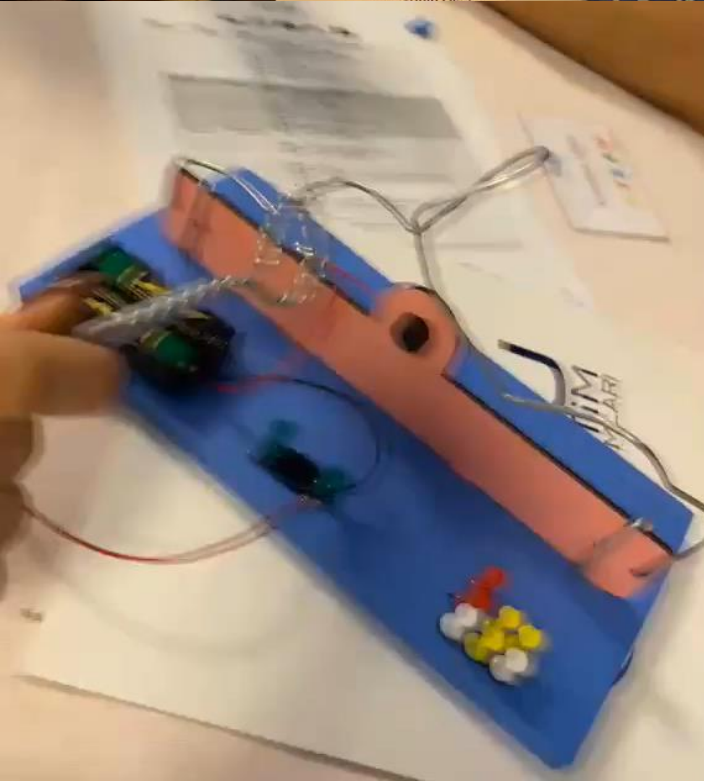
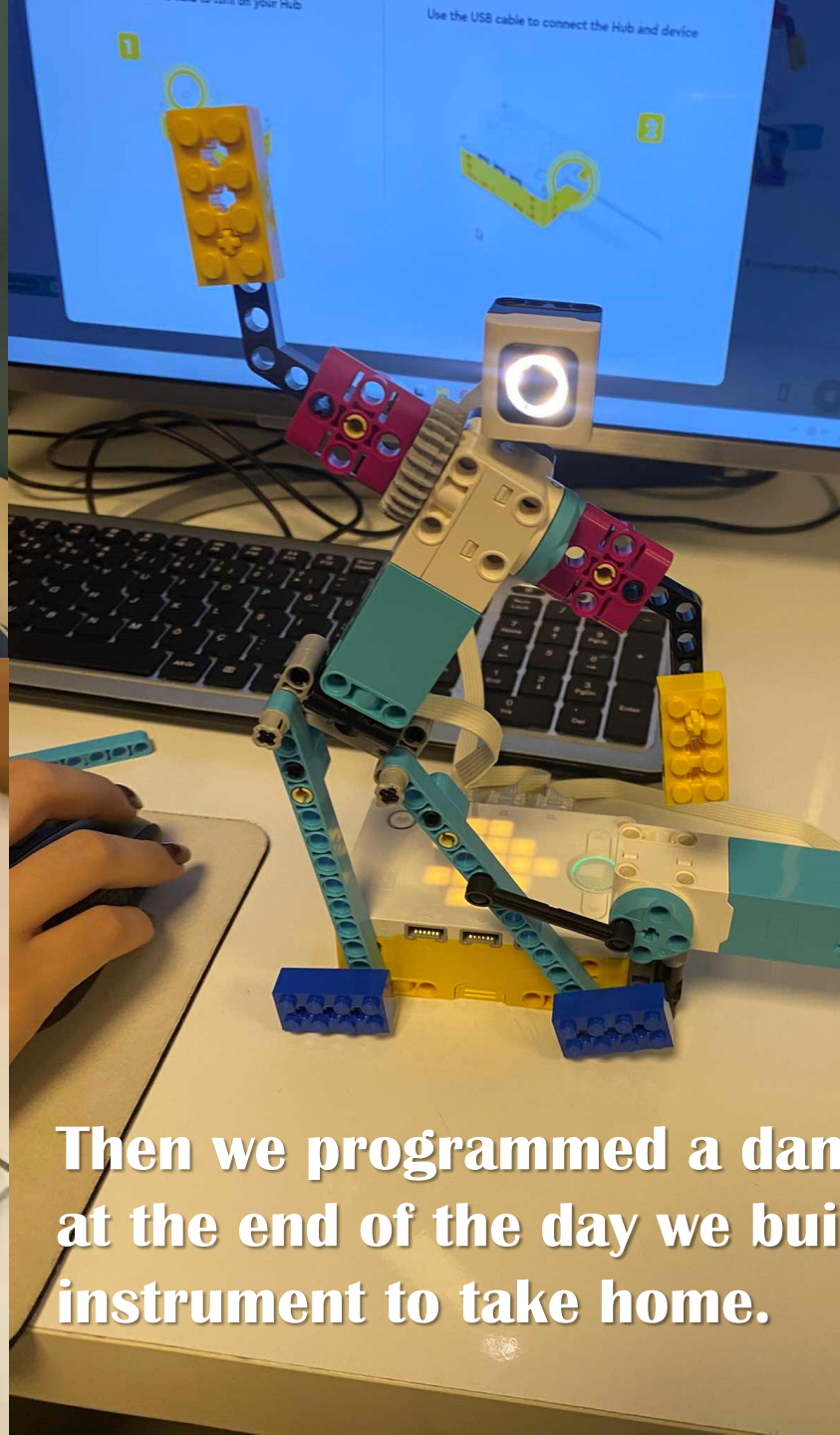




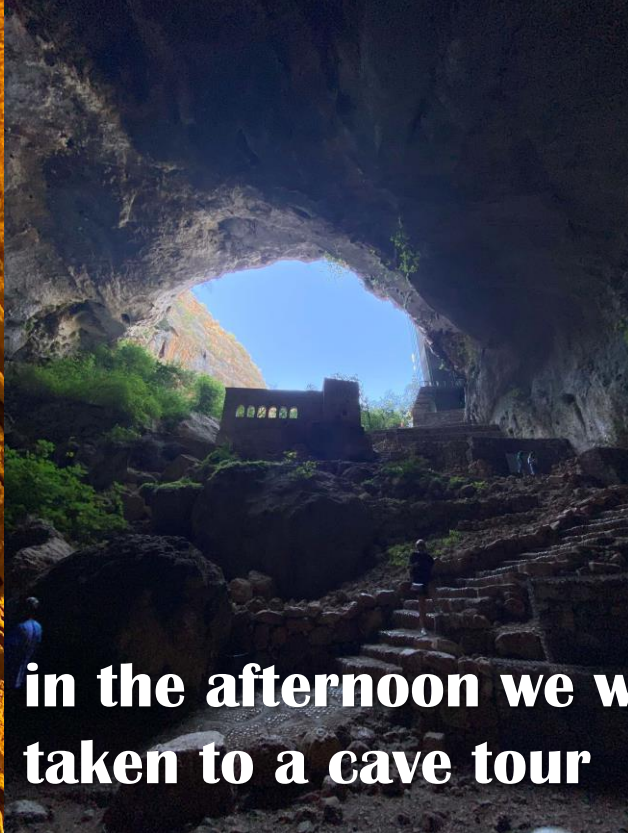
**wednesday**

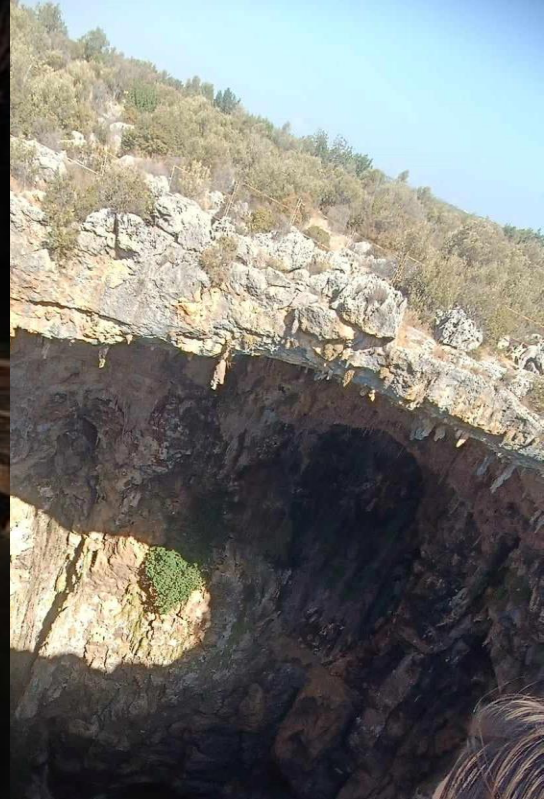




**Then we programmed a dancing robot, and at the end of the day we built an electrical instrument to take home.**

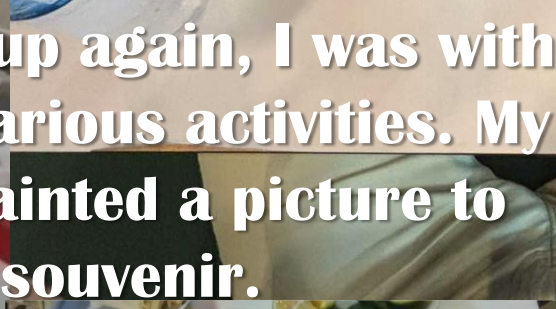


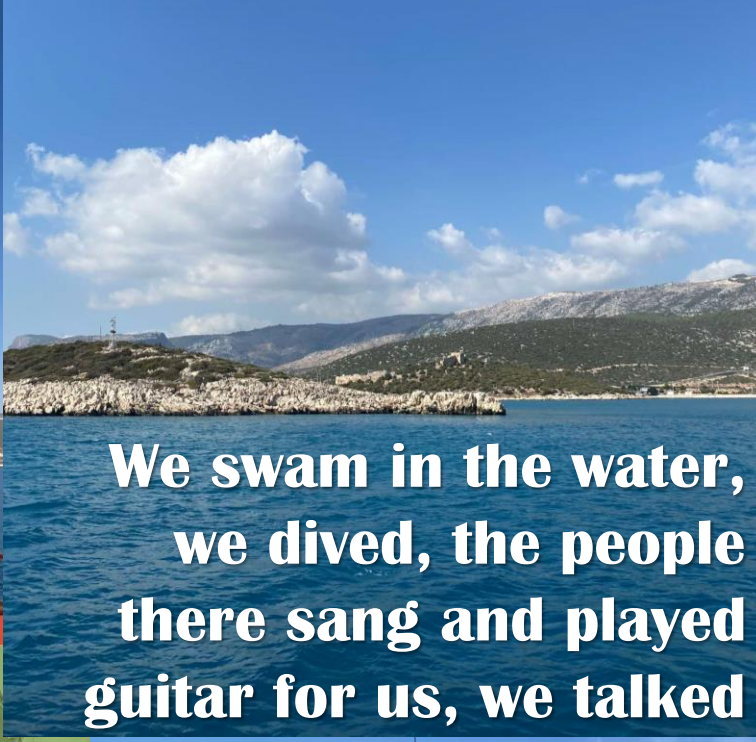
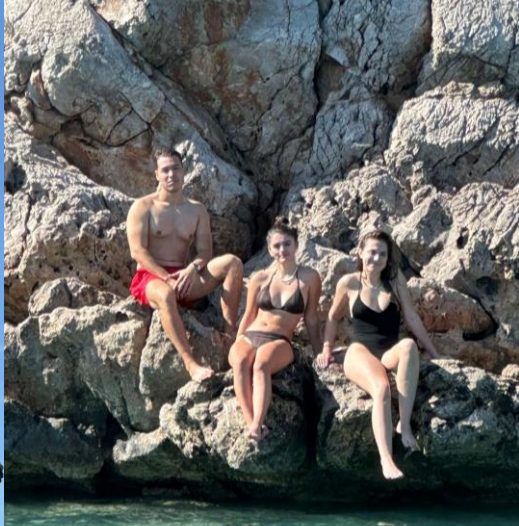
**in the afternoon we were taken to a cave tour**



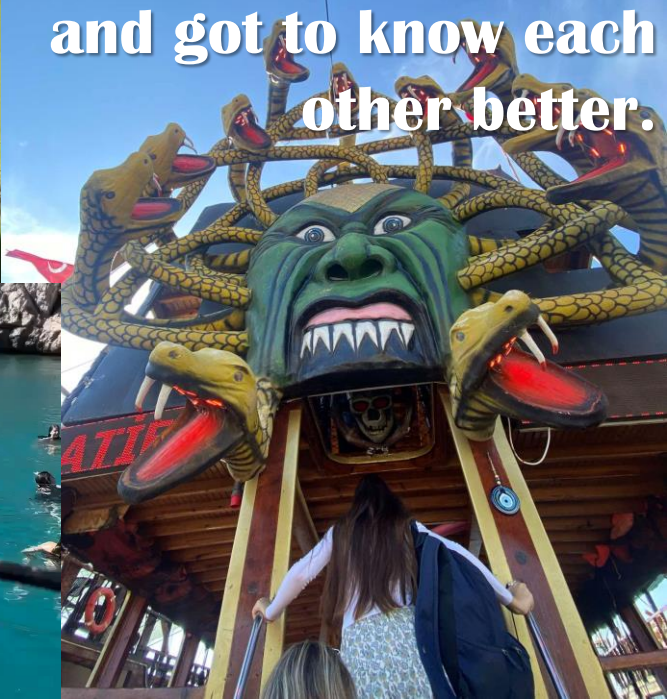
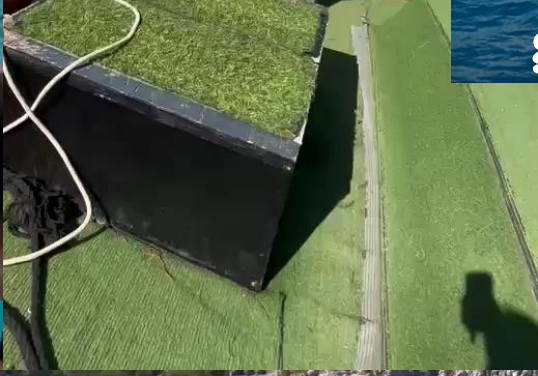


**In the evening we split up again, I was with the family and we did various activities. My host and Irmak and I painted a picture to give to each other as a souvenir.**





We swam in the water, we dived, the people there sang and played guitar for us, we talked and got to know each other better.



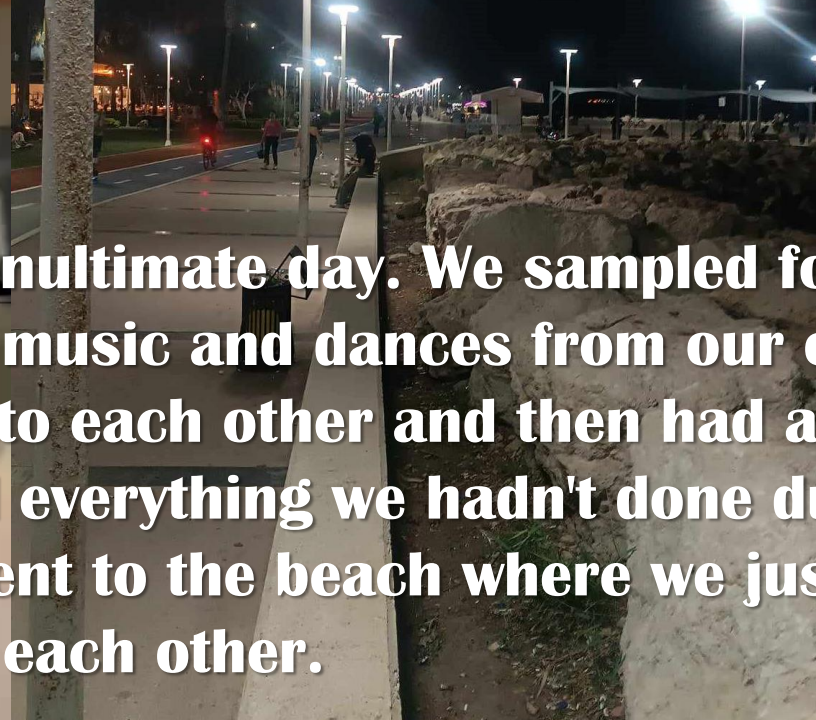
# Thursday
